CONDITIONS, REGULATIONS AND GENERAL MANAGEMENT OF NOTTINGHILL EQUESTRIAN CENTRE

THE FOLLOWING ARE AVAILABLE TO CLIENTS

STABLE FEES: R4400.00 for a horse/ R3900.00 for a pony per month payable on or before the fifth of every month.

Above mentioned includes the following:

General caring for horses by the grooms

Grooming

Cleaning and caring of feet and application of hoof oil. (Oil to be provided by client)

Trimming of insides of ears

Pulling of manes

Preventative treatments against ticks and flies (Fly spray to be provided by client)

Basic feeding of horses (grass, meal, bran, salt, epol etc.)

* Sawdust in stables

* Putting horses into paddocks daily.

GENERAL

Regular cleaning of saddle and tack provided client provides saddle soap and leather oil.

Preparation of horses for shows (before the show, pulling mane etc. preparation at shows are charged for extra)

Farrier and veterinary costs are the responsibility if the client AT ALL TIMES.

In circumstances where a horse might get sick or has injured itself, the stable manager will call out the vet immediately if needed. The account will be for the client.

The client must provide horse sickness injections once a year in August, where after the vet will be called out to do all the horses. Clients will be billed accordingly.

Deworming of horses will be done every 3 - 6 months and the client will be responsible to supply the deworming medicine or will be billed if done by the stables. Notice of deworming intentions will be on the monthly bill.

Horse flue injections are the client's own responsibility as it is not compulsory anymore. It's normally done twice a year and if the inoculations are given to the stable manager the horses will be inoculated free of charge.

Any extra medication, supplements, wound treatments etc. done by the stable manager/ staff will be added to the client's monthly stabling account.

A tack-room with locking facilities is available to the clients at their own risk and responsibility.

Grooms are not allowed to take orders from anybody except the stable manager, so please do not pay them extra for any favors. IF you need anything extra, discuss it with the stable manager and it will be attended to.

Show dates must be discussed at least three weeks in advance in order to plan food and availability of a groom for the show.

Horses will be put out in the paddocks at 09h00 in the mornings and will be taken back to their stables at 15h00 in the afternoon

If a client should need a horse in the stable at any other time, arrangements should be made with the **stable manager in advance.**

A groom will only saddle horses if prior arrangement has been made with the stable manager.

No horses will be allowed on the grass.

Riders are not allowed to ride on the cement or on the lawn around the houses and stables. NB!!!!(Nottinghill stables)

Abuse or ill treatment of horses or animals will not be tolerated.

If a client wishes to ride after 17h00 in the afternoon, it will be the rider's responsibility to see to it that the horse is properly cooled down before **putting it back into its stable.** The same rule applies for riders before 08h00 in the morning.

If the client wishes to end the service, a month's advance notice in writing is necessary.

HORSES ARE STABLED ON CLIENT'S OWN RISK. NEITHER NOTTINGHILL STABLES NOR THEIR REPRESENTATIVES WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, THEFT, INJURY OR DEATH SUSTAINED BY HORSES, RIDERS, THE PUBLIC OR THEIR PROPERTY.

CONTRACT FOR THE LIVERY, AND/OR/TRANSPORTATION OF HORSE(S) AT NOTTINGHILL EQUESTRIAN CENTRE OR WITH NOTTINGHILL EQUESTRIAN CENTRE'S TRANSPORT.

I, the undersigned do hereby accept the conditions, regulations and rules with regards to stabling and/or transporting my horse(s) at Nottingham Equestrian Centre. The horse will be stabled as from _____ **I also agree to give a month's notice** if I do wish to terminate my horse's stabling at Nottingham Equestrian Centre.

1. Nottingham Equestrian Centre as well as their representatives is hereby indemnified against all claims in loss suffered from death, transportation, damage, injury, disease, fire or any other misfortune to horse(s) or any other property while under the care of Nottingham Equestrian Centre.
2. A 50% Deposit of _____ will be payable up front on acceptance of this agreement.
3. Payments of accounts are to be settled monthly, in advance, on receipt of invoices. Nottingham Equestrian Centre shall obtain a lien over any horse(s) belonging to the owner until debt is settled. Should the debt not be settled within sixty(60) days from the date that payment is due, Nottingham Equestrian Centre shall be entitled to sell the horse(s) at its discretion for such price as it shall obtain, being under no obligation to obtain the highest possible price.
4. All costs of veterinary examinations and treatments of ailments of the horse(s) shall be the responsibility of the owner paid directly to the veterinarian involved in the case. Nottingham Equestrian Centre shall be entitled to appoint a veterinarian surgeon in its sole discretion.
5. All deworming, vaccinations, farrier, and extra costs shall be debited to the owner's account.
6. All horse(s) shall on arrival be subject to Nottingham Equestrian Centre's normal management procedures.
7. This contract may be cancelled either by Nottingham Equestrian Centre or the owner, provided one calendar month's written notice is given by either party.
