STABLE FEES 2019: R6000.00 for a horse/ R4900.00 for a pony per month payable on or before the fifth of every month.

Subject to yearly increase

PLEASE NOTE: Should it occur that your stabling account is paid later than the 5th of the month and additional R200 per week will be added to your account.

Above mentioned includes the following:

General caring for horses by the grooms

Grooming

Cleaning and care of hooves, application of hoof oil. (Oil to be provided by client)

Trimming of insides of ears

Pulling of manes

Preventative treatments against ticks and flies (Fly spray and any other preventative treatment products to be provided by client)

Basic feeding of horses (grass, meal, bran, salt, epol etc.)

* Sawdust in stables

* Taking out horses into paddocks daily.

Regular cleaning of saddle and tack provided client provides saddle soap and leather oil.

Preparation of horses for shows (before the show, pulling mane etc. preparation at shows are charged for extra)

GENERAL

- 10% Commission on the agreed sales price will be charged for horses sold on behalf of the owner.
- Any problem relating to the management of the stables must be reported to the stable manager.
- Any person found using horses or tack that does not belong to them without the permission of the owner, will be asked to leave the yard.
- Theft of any nature will not be tolerated
- Nottingham Equestrian reserves a lien over a horse in the case of an unpaid account.
- Only the Stable manager may instruct the grooms. **Do not pay them extra for any favors. IF you need anything extra, discuss it with the stable manager and it will be attended to.**
- **A groom will only saddle horses if prior arrangement has been made with the stable manager.**
- No horses will be allowed on the grass.
- **Riders are not allowed to ride on the cement or on the lawn around the houses and stables.**
- Please be mindful and respectful to other clients at the yard.
- Abuse or ill treatment of horses or animals will not be tolerated.
- If a client wishes to ride after 17h00 in the afternoon, it will be the rider's responsibility to see to it that the horse is properly cooled down before **taking it back into its stable**. The same rule applies for riders before 08h00 in the morning.
- NB NB! 30 day written notice must be giving should you wish to cancel your livery contract.

HORSES HEALTH AND HYGIENE

If a horse is represented by a person who is not its owner, it is assumed that this person has the necessary authority from the owner to deal with all matters pertaining to the horse.

- Hoof oil, fly spray and tick grease must be provided by the owner of the horse. Confirm with the stable manager that you have supplied the products and how you want them utilized for you horse/s
- The stable manager is dedicated the serving the best interests of the horses. They cannot however be held responsible for the failure to identify or diagnose a medical condition. Also they cannot be held responsible for not identifying a potentially dangerous circumstance which a horse may be exposed to.
- The final responsibility for the horse's health and well being rests with its owner.
- All horses will be dewormed and vaccinated on the same day in accordance with the program agreed to with the Vet.
- Nottingham Equestrian Estate reserves the right to call out a vet on behalf of the owner, and at the owner's expense where this is considered necessary. All attempts will be made to contact the owner before the vet is called.
- Farrier and veterinary costs are the responsibility of the client AT ALL TIMES.

HORSES ARE STABLED ON CLIENT’S OWN RISK. NEITHER NOTTINGHILL STABLES NOR THEIR REPRESENTATIVES WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, THEFT, INJURY OR DEATH SUSTAINED BY HORSES, RIDERS, THE PUBLIC OR THEIR PROPERTY.

I _____ (Name & Surname) declare that I have read and understand the rules as set out in this document and further state that all information provided by me are to my knowledge true and correct. I agree to be bound by the relevant rules of Nottingham Equestrian Estate.

I also agree to give a month’s notice if I do wish to terminate my horse’s stabling at Nottingham Equestrian Centre.

- Nottingham Equestrian Centre as well as their representatives is hereby indemnified against all claims in loss suffered from death, transportation, damage, injury, disease, fire or any other misfortune to horse(s) or any other property while under the care of Nottingham Equestrian Centre.
- A 50% Deposit of _____ will be payable up front on acceptance of this agreement.
- Payments of accounts are to be settled monthly, in advance, on receipt of invoices. Nottingham Equestrian Centre shall obtain a lien over any horse(s) belonging to the owner until debt is settled. Should the debt not be settled within sixty(60) days from the date that payment is due, Nottingham Equestrian Centre shall be entitled to sell the horse(s) at its discretion for such price as it shall obtain, being under no obligation to obtain the highest possible price.
- All costs of veterinary examinations and treatments of ailments of the horse(s) shall be the responsibility of the owner paid directly to the veterinarian involved in the case. Nottingham Equestrian Centre shall be entitled to appoint a veterinarian at its sole discretion.
- All deworming, vaccinations, farrier, and extra costs shall be debited to the owner’s account.
- All horse(s) shall on arrival be subject to Nottingham Equestrian Centre’s normal management procedures.
- This contract may be cancelled either by Nottingham Equestrian Centre or the owner, provided one calendar month’s written notice is given by either party.
